#### **Cons:**

- S For the cost.
  - Slower.
- 🖙 Battery life can be an issue if you are unable to plug in.

Representation of the Flash drives and SD cards (128 MB - 256 GB)

(1 GB = 1,024 MB = 1,048,576 English characters)

# Email

- Used for communicating with others.
- Cocally installed program (client) and internet via browser.
- Reference Free clients at:
  - 103 Windows, Mac, Android, or Apple iPad
- Reference accounts:
  - **Gmail**, <u>Yahoo</u>, and <u>Outlook</u>
- Good if includes an address book that contains name, email(s), phone, mailing address, web page and social media contact info like Facebook, Twitter, etc.

### Browsers

- All Browsers are free, find the one you like. They are written for all systems.
  - **Google Chrome**
  - **Mozilla Firefox**
  - **Microsoft Internet Explorer**
  - **Apple Safari**
  - Opera Opera
  - Others are available but not in common use.

# Genealogy Programs

- Used to record the person and family information you find.
- Should be able to attach documents, pictures and video.
- Creates Gedcom files.

- Suggested Family Tree Maker and Legacy (free version available).

# **Editors**

#### CB

- ₩ord processors write history.
  - Microsoft's Word (\$), or Window's WordPad.
  - Corel's WordPerfect (\$).
  - 🗷 LibreOffice or OpenOffice's Writer.
- Text editors work with text files.
  - Window's Notepad or Mac's TextEdit.
  - ∞ Notepad++.
- Notebooks & Journals.
  - Locally installed and online.

# Database Programs



- Use to create custom data storage
  - Microsoft's Access (\$)
  - Corel's Paradox (\$)
  - CS LibreOffice or OpenOffice's Base (Free)
- Search Internet for "free database software"

### Research Aids

- Used to capture information from the internet as is.
- Rrowser's page save.
- Pagenest grabs part or all the website and stores it
   as it is at that time on your hard drive.

# Data Exchange

- <sup>™</sup> Gedcom.

# Web Software

- Used to convert your genealogy data (gedcom) to a website.
- - Could program coverts gedcom to html (you require somewhere to host the pages). Could write it to CD/DVDs as webpages and send to family and friends.
  - Internet sites upload your gedcom and the site converts and hosts the data.

    - **™** FamilySearch

# Image Editing



- Software used to edit or convert digital images.
- Rictures have to be scanned to a file (digital image).
- Recommended:
  - **G** IrFranView
  - **S** PhotoScape
  - **©** Picasa
  - © Zoner Photo Studio (Free or \$)
- Use .tif file type for color image storage.
- Rile types .jpg, .png, .gif and .tif to store on internet.

### OCR

- Optical Character Recognition.
- Converts a picture of words to text, which saves typing.
   Accuracy depends on quality of text image.
- ™ Free online at Online OCR (max. 5MB file size).
- <sup>∞</sup> OCR software reviews.
- ™ FreeOCR (so-so, can follow columns).
- Best results obtained when image is scanned at 300dpi, converted, then check converted file with a spell checker. Hand check numbers. Then read to see what was missed.

# Virus & Malware

- Viruses are programs that reproduce themselves between computers.
- Malware is downloaded from websites you go to and only infects your computer.
- Microsoft Security Essentials (free virus protection for windows)
- Malwarebytes Anti-Malware (free malware detection version available).
- Apple claims not a problem

# Backup

- Protect your data by compressing and copying it. Store it off computer.
- Write to CD/DVDs and store off site.
- Rurchase and backup to an external hard drive.
- See Cloud Storage following.

# Cloud Storage

- Good for backup, synchronization between computers, sharing large files with others.
- Requires sign up, download and install of sync program.
- Some sites:
  - **Box UK** 10GB free, largest file 250MB
  - **Copy** 15GB free

  - OneDrive 15GB free

"Find it from home" but remember not everything is on it. Nor is everything on it indexed.

- Some free blog web sites <u>Blog.com</u>, <u>Blogger.com</u>, <u>Tumblr.com</u>, <u>Webs.com</u>, and <u>WordPress.com</u>
- A desktop blog client will have to be able to post to the blog web site(s) you use. See <a href="here">here</a> for a list of recommendations.

#### Free Websites

- Two best rated places to create a free website.
  - SiteBuilder.com
  - **WebsiteBuilder.com**
  - You get free space, templates, design tool and a <u>subdirectory</u> web name.
  - S No coding needed.
  - Costs to have your own domain name.
- Contact me if you are considering purchasing a domain name and setting up a website.

- Google books for out of print books that you can download to your computer, e-book or read online.

# Capturing the Internet

- Never retype. Highlight text then copy to clipboard and save clipboard to your editor.
- All browsers have the ability to save the page. Usability of results varies with browser.
- Website grab programs like PageNest saves the whole thing to your hard drive.
- Remember everything has to be verified and if used you need to cite source like always.

# Things that are useful.



- Captop or tablet (record information).
- Notebook software (research notes).
- Remail if site is to far to travel to.

# DNA Testing



Finding your ancestors through genetics.

## DNA Testing



- The number of segments tested determines price, \$99-\$900US
- The more segments tested, the more information to compare with.
- To find ancestors, you must match with someone else that has be tested and done genealogy that will help you.
- Choose a company with a very big database so you have a better change of matching with someone.
